The Lilies of The Valley

In all suffering there will be Grace

What is in the human mind that cause "the fear of death"?
What most people would answer is: The fear of "suffering".

The fear of suffering worsen the actual suffering itself. Suffering causes our focus to turn inward. Sufferings comes in various kinds of forms in the world in which we live in. It may include physical pain, illness, violence, poverty, hunger, oppression, broken relationships, shattered dreams, broken families, dashed hopes, loneliness, discrimination, grief, abuse and even addictions. Affliction of sin.

While suffering any of the above, may cause weakness in the spirit and many will have risen fear: "I am afraid that I will never be strong enough to be a martyr this."

Our Heavenly Father knew that in this world we are going to need a Spirit of strength to overcome. As soon as we are called upon for the honor of facing the end of our life YHVH gives us the great comfort by His Spirit of Grace. He indeed gives us all the courage and power needed through the Spirit He invested within us.

When the hour of testing comes, the Holy Spirit will rest upon us in such a way that what seemed impossible, becomes miraculously possible.

Isaiah 41:10

Fear not, for I Am with you; be not dismayed, for I Am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.

This verse is one of the most precious promises about the work of the Holy Spirit in our lives and one of the greatest enticements we have for seeking YHVH with all our heart, in times of trouble or even before we come to the end of our lives.

Even in the darkest hour YHVH is with us and when we allow His Holy Spirit to fight within us, we have nothing to fear about because His Grace is sufficient in all our needs.

Beloved, do not be surprised at the fiery trial when it comes upon you to test you, as though something strange were happening to you. But rejoice insofar as you share sufferings, that you may also rejoice and be glad when His glory is revealed. If you are insulted for the name of Yeshua you are blessed, *because the Spirit of Glory and of YHVH rests upon you.*

This may be a repeated experience in our lives, or it may be the final work of the Holy Spirit before we cross over in the everlasting life.

Recall the time on the cross how Yeshua HaMashiach gave his spirit over into the most High and exalting power that even risen Yeshua from the tomb.

“The Spirit of Glory and of YHVH rests upon you,” as you endure your sufferings: The Spirit of God, the Spirit of glory, will come to you and rest upon you in the hour of your trial.

In the hour of our trial, the question of many will be : Where are You YHVH?

Psalm 23:4

Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.

The answer that YHVH himself will give you is this: “I Am here resting upon you. I Am here.”

The evil spirit will always try to weaken us in Spirit, body and mind. He wants us to feel lost, in shame, degradation, misery, filth, ugliness and the furthest thing imaginable from the Glory of YHVH.

All Glory to the Spirit of YHVH that still has the last word.
“The Spirit of Glory and of God rests upon you.”

He is the Spirit of truth (John 14:17; 15:26; 16:13) and brings to our mind whatever truth we need. Righteousness.

All the forces of darkness will seek to confuse and obscure the light of truth in that hour.

The goal of the evil one, is to dethrone YHVH from His Holiness and make it appear that YHVH look distant and ineffective.

The work of the Holy Spirit in that hour is the work of the Spirit of truth that will rest upon us with whatever measure of truth we will need in order to be faithful.

The essence of the Holy Spirit is to magnify the beauty of YHVH in every human mind and heart as we are His children.

Yeshua said, "I am with you *always*, to the end of the age" (Matthew 28:20). The work of the Holy Spirit is to cause us to remember Yeshua, and to see him with the eyes of our hearts (2 Corinthians 3:17–18; Ephesians 1:17–18).

Yeshua HaMashiach came to fulfillment of the Glory and Spirit of YHVH. His beautiful Spirit and preciousness of his love communicates to our hearts . With the power of endurance Yeshua showed victoriously that he feared no evil. His path of suffering right to the cross reminds us of the power of strength of the Holy Spirit of YHVH.

1 Peter 4:14

"The Spirit of glory and of YHVH rests upon you". How can we resist that power? It is better to lose fear as it is not worth keeping. The glory we are about to gain is infinitely better.

The Spirit of glory will cause us to experience the reality of 1 Peter 5:10–11: “And after you have suffered a little while, the God of all grace, who has called you to *his eternal glory* in Yeshua, will himself restore, confirm, strengthen, and establish you. To him be the dominion forever and ever. Amen.”

As “the Spirit of glory” rests upon you, He will give you a taste of that “eternal glory.”

Romans 8:15–17

For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, “Abba! Father!” The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs, heirs of YHVH and fellow heirs with Yeshua, provided we suffer with him in order that we may also be glorified with him.

The Spirit of glory rests upon you and testifies to your heart: “You are an heir of infinite glory. You belong to YHVH. You will be saved and redeemed by His Name

Yeshua said, “Do not be anxious beforehand what you are to say, but say whatever is given you in that hour, for it is not you who speak, but the Holy Spirit” (Mark 13:11). The Spirit of glory and of YHVH will rest upon you. If, in His power, He wants you to “be still” and “know” He is God.

2 Corinthians 13:14: "The Grace of Yeshua HaMashiach and the love of YHVH and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you."

May you experience the precious, personal presence of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit.

In the hour of our trial our Heavenly Father still cares with His tenderness for His child. He sends us His Son the Savior with redeeming love to cover all our sin, and with the Spirit's sustaining of faith so that we taste in that hour the preciousness of the presence of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

YHVH has more grace and greater enjoyments for those who seek him.

Jeremiah 29:13

"You will seek Me and find Me, when you seek Me with all your heart"

Because YHVH has a plan for us, even bad news fits within His vision. Therefore we do not need to fret over things. We just need to trust that He is doing what is best for us.

Joshua 1:9

I've commanded you to be brave and strong, haven't I? Don't be alarmed or terrified, because YHVH your God is with you wherever you go."

With YHVH on our side, we have nothing to truly fear. Having faith means that we get to know that our prayers are heard by YHVH and that He is on with us always.

2 Timothy 4:18

YHVH will rescue me from every evil action and will save me for His Heavenly Kingdom. To him be the glory forever and always. Amen.

Our Heavenly Father and great I Am, full of Mercy and Grace, let Your loving kindness comfort us in Spirit and truth. Strengthen us in our faith as we invite You to take authority of our lives. Fill us with renewed hope and guide us to walk in wholeness and righteousness.

Luke 11:1-4, when one of Yeshua's disciples ask Him, "Master, teach us to pray," Yeshua replied by giving us the most important prayer that we should recite countless times throughout our lifetime.

In these few words there is great spiritual strength. It's important to remind ourselves to pause and reflect on the words we are praying to enable the Holy Spirit to manifest in our beings.

Allow YHVH to move forward with Mercy and Grace giving us the most important needs for our salvation. While we invite the Holy Spirit in let us reflect on the words from our Spirit.

Our Father, Who are in heaven

YHVH is mindful of His children.. To YHVH His Holiness is in His Spirit of a loving Father. He is the head of His family. YHVH discipline His children and created order as Father. YHVH Himself is Almighty to be seated upon His throne in the Kingdom of heaven the Highest place of Authority and there is no one above Him.

Holy be Thy Name

By the Holy Name of YHVH we are saved. By His Holy Name we are called By confessing His Name, we recognize that He is Who, He Said, He is. All powerful, full of Mercy and Grace. As we pray for deliverance we are healed, restored and renewed. Trust the mercy of YHVH and His love.

Trust YHVH to take care of the things that you can't. Trust YHVH for the impossible-miracles that is in His power. He is always in control even when your circumstances may seem out of control. YHVH never disappoints anyone who puts their trust in Him. Never be afraid to trust an unknown future to you, but certainly known by YHVH

YHVH is with you always, even in the worst of times. His presence is with you, protecting you and working for you. He has empowered you with everything you need to face those difficulties confronting you.
